Tutoring

It is expected that every effort will be made to resolve the learning problems of a student at school before the recommendation that parents engage a tutor or seek other outside professional help. The Board of Education believes that by maintaining high quality instructional staff and providing for a rich, varied curriculum the need for individual tutoring is minimized.

Personnel -- Certified

Tutoring

Teachers employed by the Weston Board of Education may tutor pupils of the Weston Public Schools for pay provided that:

- 1. The tutoring begins not earlier than 1 hour after the daily closing of school.
- 2. The pupils are not students enrolled in any class taught by the tutor.
- 3. School premises are not used for the tutoring sessions.
- 4. No school system grades or credits are given for the tutoring work.
- 5. Teachers interested in serving as tutors register in the guidance office with the list of available tutors made available to parents upon request.
- 6. The tutor files notice in the guidance office that tutoring arrangements have been made.
- 7. Parents/guardians are fully informed that the agreement for tutoring and any financial arrangements thereto are strictly between the parent/guardian and the tutor and is not sponsored or approved by the Weston Public Schools.

Parents and/or guardians wishing an exception to this regulation may refer their request to the Superintendent of Schools.
