

How to find your child's bus route in Parent Portal

Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year bus routes will no longer be published on the website or in the paper. You will find your student's bus route in Parent Portal. If your child(ren) take the bus from or to a second home, please contact the transportation department (davelustberg@westonps.org) for information on the second bus route.

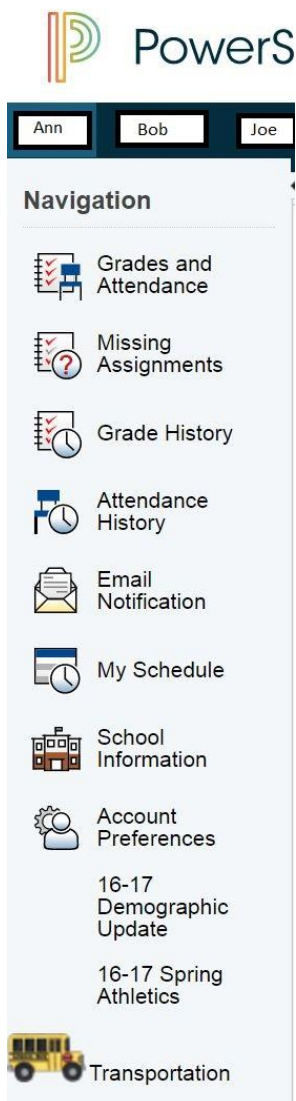
Directions for how to see bus routes in parent portal:

Log into parent portal at: www.weston.powerschool.com/public

Step 1. Click the name of your first student in the upper left hand corner of parent portal once you are logged in.



Step 2. Now look at the links on the left and select transportation



You will see the bus route information for the student you clicked on in step 1.

Here is an example of the bus route information for sample student Ann Smith:

Transportation Information For: **Smith, Ann**



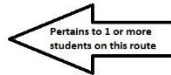
Bus Stop Times: Estimated AM pick-up and PM drop-off times listed on your bus route schedule can be different from the actual times your bus is reaching your stop depending on which students assigned to a particular bus are using the bus service on a given day or at all. Your actual bus stop time should become established over the first week or two of school based on the ridership on your particular bus. Thereafter, the times should be consistent, within a few minute range, even if they differ from the original estimated times.

A.M. BUS STOP: **123 Main Street**

A.M. BUS NUMBER: **HM-16**

A.M. TIME: **7:17:00 AM** NOTE: This is an APPROXIMATE time.

A.M. BUS COMMENTS: **HM-16 AM (NUT/EGG/FISH/MUSTARD ALLERGY ON BOARD)**

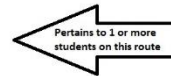


P.M. BUS STOP: **123 Main Street**

P.M. BUS NUMBER: **HM-16**

P.M. TIME: **3:09:00 PM** NOTE: This is an APPROXIMATE time.

P.M. BUS COMMENTS: **HM-16 PM (NUT/EGG/FISH/MUSTARD ALLERGY ON BOARD)**



Bus Comments: The information contained in the bus comment fields applies to 1 or more students on that bus route, not necessarily your student. If your student's allergy information is missing please contact the transportation department.

To find the bus route for another student, click on that student's name as you did in Step 1, then scroll down to the transportation link and click there. That will be the bus information for the student whose name you chose in step 1. Repeat this process for each of your students.
